Call for nominations to the executive

The terms of office of the current ACDICT executive expire at the end of the ACM on Tuesday 18 June 2024. Nominations are now called for a number of positions on the executive, to serve until the end of the ACM in 2026.

The executive currently consists of:

Following the ACM, the current president will become the immediate past president and the current president-elect will become the president. The new executive will appoint one of its elected members as treasurer. It may also choose to co-opt members.

Nominations are now called for the position of vice-president and three positions as members of the executive. All current ordinary members of the executive are eligible to nominate for a further term.

The constitution requires nominees to be present in person at the ACM.
